



#### 1. Macro level:

- A. Integration of healthcare and social care
- B. Sufficient numeration, based on capitation fee
- C. Increasing PC workforce vocational GP training

#### 2. Meso level:

- A. Multidisciplinary Primary Care Units
- B. Interprofessional collaboration and training

#### 3. Micro level:

A. Personal Continuity of care

B. Patient empowerment






